27 Rivalry Chenin Blanc <i>South Africa</i> Unwooded and unpretentious, this wine is sustainably crafted, it offers intense tropical fruit flavours balanced by a crisp, fresh finish. (2)	£28.00
28 Grand'Arte Alvarinho <i>Portugal</i> Real finesse with an intense aroma of ripe orchard fruits. The body is full with a delicious, creamy tropical character yet has a fresh, citrus quality and a long finish. (2)	£30.00
29 Fincas de Azabache Tempranillo Blanco <i>Spain</i> This is a real find. White Tempranillo is a 'new' grape variety but closely linked to the well known red Tempranillo grown all over Spain. This style is robust yet unoaked, with apple refreshment and elegantly balanced. (1)	£32.50

53 Ermita de San Felices Reserva <i>Spain</i> Intensely concentrated with blackberry fruit and wonderful enriching sweetness. Beginning to show meaty, gamey, leathery development with a finish that lasts forever. Fabulous! (D)	£48.00
54 Morgon Les Corcelettes Louis Latour <i>France</i> Floral aromas with subtle hints of violet and blackberry prior to a full-bodied palate with ample fruit and silky tannins. (D)	£50.00

56 Rocca di Montemassi <i>Italy</i> This superb Tuscan is ruby red with garnet reflections. Complex aromas showing cherry, plum and currant with notes of violet, eucalyptus, vanilla and sweet tobacco. A rich and elegant palate of fresh fruit showing spicy toasted notes. (D)	£80.00
57 Chateau Musar <i>Lebanon</i> Blood red in colour with a rich, fragrant fruit nose; mulberries, black cherries, plums with a hint of mocha. The palate is very intense and concentrated, it's full of volume and characterised by forest and black fruits with elegant spice. The tannins are soft and juicy and it has a lengthy finish. (D)	£85.00
58 Château Potensac <i>France</i> Classic notes of red and blackcurrants, earth and spice are well-presented in this deep ruby/purple coloured, medium-bodied wine, which should drink nicely for a decade or more. (C)	£85.00
59 Aloxe-Corton Louis Latour <i>France</i> Intense cherry aromas with notes of liquorice with discreet tannins, a subtle earthiness and gentle spice. (C)	£120.00
60 Château Léoville-Las-Cases 2ème Cru Classé <i>France</i> Very dark in colour with black edges leading to brick red. It has a cool and intensely concentrated fruit aroma with a powerful finish. (D)	£275.00
